Good Morning Jonathan

Thank you for your enquiry.

Having reviewed the documentation you sent through regarding the proposed installation of 3 x 83m³ (249m³) Diesel Aboveground Storage Tanks (AST's) on Erf 601, Stasie Road, Lutzville, West Coast District, I can confirm that the proposal does not trigger s38(1) of the NHRA and therefore no NID is required for submission. Please use this correspondence as proof of HWC's review.

As the erf is largely developed, inclusive of a fuel service station (including a forecourt area), Agrimark convenience store, Agrimark warehouse and Agrimark retail store, and parking bays, the additional storage tanks do not pose a change in character. Archaeological and Palaeontological sensitivities have also been deemed negligible.

All the best for the project ahead.
